Narrative:

It is estimated that \$1,500,000 per year would be needed to pay the bounties established by this bill.

The bill also eliminates the need for furbearer licenses for most furbearer species. It is estimated that the number of furbearer hunting and trapping licenses sold would decrease from 8,000 to 3,000. This would reduce revenue by \$35,000 per year.
