Narrative:

Page 1, lines 16 thru 18 eliminate the furbearer license requirement for most North Dakota furbearer hunters and trappers. It is estimated that revenue from furbearer licenses will be reduced by \$125,000 per year.

This bill authorizes the Commissioner to prescribe the manner, number, and places for taking predators for which a bounty shall be paid. It is not known what the next Game and Fish Commissioner will prescribe. A \$10,000 or less cost per year is probably a reasonable estimate.
