Narrative:

The inclusion of revised section 21 of HB 1297, providing for registration fees, would require the assignment of personnel to carryout the activity.

Since all forms and sizes of containers appear to be inclusive under the definition Tank, it is not ascertainable as to the number of owners and/or operators that would be required to register. However, if it is presumed that the intent of the amendment is to include only those that are owners or operators of tanks for the purpose of selling petroleum products, an estimated 7,000 units would be subject to registration and requiring two FTE positions to accomplish the administration.
