Narrative:

HB 1364 increase supplementary benefits under Chapter 65-05.2. Minimum benefits for qualifying claimants (58) receiving permanent total or temporary total benefits would increase from \$150 to \$165 per week, estimated cost would be \$1,640,000. Minimum benefits for qualifying claimants (286) receiving survivor death benefits would increase from \$90 to \$105 per week, estimated cost would be \$2,080,000. Total estimated cost would be \$3,720,000.


