Narrative:

HB 1364 Increase supplementary benefits under Chapter 65-05.2. Minimum benefits for qualifying claimants (202) receiving permanent total or temporary total benefits would increase from \$150 to \$160 per week, estimated cost would be \$1,094,000. Minimum benefits for qualifying claimants (286) receiving survivor death benefits would increase from \$90 to \$100 per week, estimated cost would be \$1,451,000. Total estimated cost would be \$2,545,000 over the life of eligible claimants.

The total impact of the change would be reflected in the Bureau's financial statements as of July 1, 1989, due to the fact that these funds would be committed. Actual payout for the 1989-91 biennium would be approximately \$451,000.
