Narrative:

House Bill 1475 as amended, specifically those areas of Chapter 4-35 of the North Dakota Century Code addressed in this Bill that deals with the certification requirements for commercial applicators and dealers will have no fiscal impact on the state general fund or any city general fund.

House Bill 1475, specifically that area of Chapter 4-35 of the North Dakota Century Code that eliminates the commercial applicator and dealer licensure requirement will have a fiscal impact to counties. The state's county treasurers license approximately 1,500 applicators at \$20 per applicant and 1,000 dealers at \$10 per dealer annually. The fiscal impact would be \$20,000 annually. Considering 53 counties, each county would be impacted by \$755 per year.
