Narrative:

REVENUE: This bill legalizes electronic gaming devices of games of chance. Paper-type games of charitable gaming tickets (pull tabs and jars) and punchboards would no longer be conducted by gaming organizations.

The historical gaming tax rate of 5% would apply to the adjusted gross proceeds.

EXPENSE: Salaries, fringe benefits, operating expenses, data processing, and equipment expenses approximating \$500,000 is required by the Attorney General's office for proper regulation of electronic gaming devices.
