Narrative:

Senate Bill No. 2082 would reduce the amount of the state's Legislative Assembly employer Social Security contribution during the 1989-91 biennium on payments to legislators (from \$90 to \$73 per day on legislator salaries and \$180 per month as an expense allowance rather than compensation). In addition to the amounts (\$73,605) below for the 1989-91 biennium, a reduction in employer Social Security payments during the 1987-1989 biennium (the 51st Legislative Assembly) would be an estimated \$30,150.

This fiscal note is based on all legislators making this election - this might not be the case. It does not include additional savings resulting from legislators going home on a weekend during which time they may not be eligible to claim meal allowances.
