Narrative:

No initial cost for administration. However, potential fiscal impact depending on source of State matching funds. State matching funds could be appropriated, bonded, or received through a repayable loan through the Bank of North Dakota. The fund will provide matching monies for low interest loans to North Dakota political subdivisions to fund construction of sewage treatment facilities.

It is projected that \$10.7 million federal dollars will be available in fiscal years 1989 and 1990 on a 80% federal/20% state funding ratio.
