Narrative:

SB 2182 would have minimal impact on state general and special funds. A few dollars would be needed to set up the account, but a portion of the cost would be offset by any interest generated on the account. This account would be used to deposit cash deposits paid by applicants for transient merchant licenses who do not provide a surety bond. This money would be refunded to transient merchants upon expiration of the two-year period if consumers do not file claims against the bond. For the last calendar year, approximately \$11,000 would have been held in this account.


