Narrative:

SB 2254 provides that the state contribution for health insurance would be based on the full-time equivalency of a position. For example, if a position is being filled on a half-time basis or a .5 FTE, the state would contribute 1/2 of the premium required for health insurance coverage.

An exception is made for teachers at the State Industrial School, Grafton, School for the Deaf, School for the Blind, and the Division of Independent Study, when the FTE calculation results in a less than full-time status because of a 9- or 10-month contract. In that case, the full amount of the premium would be provided.

The executive budget is based on this bill and assumes a total savings of \$615,852 as a result.
