In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Non profit Corporation fees

Narrative: There are currently 11,330 non profit domestic and foreign corporations including 3,132 churches, filed in the secretary of states office dating back to 1898. Thirty percent of those corporations were issued certificates prior to 1959. The fee is not consistent with regular corporation annual report filing fees of \$20.00

Contractors fees. There are currently 1595 Class A contractors and 571 Class B contractors in the state. The average number of new contractors applying for a new license is approximately 10% each year. The breakdown of contractors by class for 1987 was: A - 1595; B - 571; C - 695; D - 2245. The number of renewals is approximately 90% and the number of penalty renewal applications is 5%. Based on these factors, the fiscal effect is \$127,330.

Notaries fees. There are a total of 3,874 notaries that are scheduled to for renewal in the next biennium. The fiscal effect of increasing the fee by \$10.00 or 50% is 38,740 for the biennium.


