Narrative:

This bill would transfer the administration of the surface of the beds of navigable lakes and streams from the board of university and school lands to the state engineer. The result would be a minor decrease in management expenditures for the state land department and a similar increase for the state engineer. Past experience has shown that these management costs are negligible and the fiscal effect should be the same. We do not anticipate any reduction in staff or operating expenses for the land department or the need for any additional staff by the state engineer if these properties are transferred. The greatest savings will be to the public in the cost of obtaining permits and otherwise dealing with state agencies.
