Narrative:

In order to carry out the provisions of Senate Bill No. 2336, the Attorney General's budget should be increased by \$101,000. The supreme court's staff estimates that \$33,000 will be needed to cover the expenses associated with a portion of N.D.C.C. § 27-20-49, as amended, which would require the Attorney General to pay the expenses of service of summons, notices, subpoenas, travel expenses of witnesses, and other like expenses incurred in juvenile court cases. They also estimate that \$50,000 would be necessary to pay for prosecution witness fees and expenses. In addition, it is estimated that a half-time clerical person will be required to handle these transactions at a cost of \$18,000 for the biennium.

If this legislation is adopted, the supreme court's budget can be reduced by \$83,000 to reflect the transfer of responsibility for payment of witness fees and expenses to the Attorney General's budget.


