Narrative:

SB-2349 was initiated from Human Services & Veterans Affairs Committee during testimony on SB-2150 on 5 Jan 89. SB-2150 proposes to extend the repayment period of a loan from the Department of Veterans Affairs from 2 to 4 years. Senator Nalewaja asked why wasn't the Veterans Aid program extended to the surviving spouse of a veteran if the surviving spouse has not remarried? This question prompted SB-2349 which amends sections 37-14-03.3, 37-14-04, 37-14-05, 37-14-06 & 37-14-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the veterans' aid loan. The extent of usage is unmeasurable at this time. However, it is assumed that it will NOT effect the loan reserves to the extent additional funds would be required during the present 1989-1991 biennium.
