Narrative:

The Bill requires scientific analyses of skeletal remains in the Physical Anthropology Collection (PAC) of the State Historical Society, and specifies some of the studies to be completed. The PAC may contain as many as 800 individuals represented by as little as one bone or as much as a complete skeleton; of these approximately 150 individuals have been analyzed except for the DNA studies. Recent low bids for comparable projects conducted for federal agencies have been \$200.00 per individual, not including DNA studies which could raise the cost to \$300.00 per individual. While the Smithsonian Institution offered as recently as October, 1987, to complete portions of the analyses required by this bill at no cost to the State, we have estimated the cost on the basis of a competitive bidding process for the entire project. The cost would be a one-time rather than continuing cost.
