Narrative: It is estimated that the revenue collected under this bill will be \$950,000 for the 1991-93 biennium and be deposited in a solid waste management fund. Appropriations from the solid waste management fund for the 1991-93 biennium are estimated at \$500,000 as follows:

State Department of Health and Consolidated Laboratories	\$220,000
State Water Commission	\$140,000
State Geologist	<u>\$140,000</u>
	\$500,000

This bill also provides an appropriation to the State Department of Health and Consolidated Laboratories in the amount of \$450,000 from the state aid distribution fund. Of this appropriation, \$350,000 is to be distributed to solid waste management districts and \$100,000 is to be used by the State Health Department to provide assistance to the solid waste management districts.
