ISD ACTS AS A SERVICE BUREAU AND PROVIDES THE EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL TO SUPPORT THE MICROFILM SERVICE. ISD BILLS EACH AGENCY BASED ON A RATE REQUIRED TO RECOVER THE COST OF PROVIDING THE SERVICE.
