Narrative:

With no history of fee collections, we cannot know how much money may be raised by charging for Core Library usage. However, we expect that the initiation of fees for this purpose may raise in excess of \$15,000. We may also initiate fees for other Geological Survey services, but again, with no history, we cannot predict how much money these services will raise. All money raised through fees for Geological Survey services will be placed in a fund that we will use to purchase publications and other reference materials for use by Survey staff and by other State agencies.
