Narrative:

This bill enables the Attorney General's office to deposit into the attorney general consumer protection fund the costs, expenses, and attorney's fees incurred and collected by the attorney general as a result of an inquiry or investigation.

Also, the bill enables the Attorney General's office to charge and collect, in advance, fees to defray the actual costs of background investigations of certain applicants who apply for a gaming work permit, applicants who apply for a distributors license, and applicants who apply for a manufacturers license to sell charitable gaming tickets or paper bingo cards in North Dakota. The amount collected is placed in the attorney general's refund fund. When an investigation is conducted, any amount collected in excess of the actual costs is refunded to the applicant.
