Narrative:

During the first 9 months of 1990, only 33 specimens were furnished to the State Laboratories pursuant to section 23-07-07.1. Furthermore, there has not been a positive test in the State Laboratories for syphilis on a prenatal serum in recent memory. Under this legislation, specimens would no longer be required to be submitted to the State Laboratories.

The blood bank was closed many years ago and there is no intent to reestablish a blood bank.

The loss of fee revenues will be approximately \$2,000 per year.
