Narrative:

This engrossed bill would modify the allocation formula for distributing the total amount wagered for live and simulcast parimutuel horse racing events. The modified distribution would decrease the state tax on regular and exotic races. Also, the North Dakota racing commission would retain the unclaimed winning tickets and breakage (odd cents of winning wagers) for use in a special Racing Promotion Fund.
