Narrative:

This bill converts the current \$2.60 incentive ceiling, the funding for which is included in SB 2002, Subdivision 4, to an unlimited incentive with a minimum of \$2.60 per patient day for those facilities not exceeding the indirect care cost limit.

Total projected cost would be \$4.3 million of which Medicaid would pay \$2.3 million.
