This engrossed bill clarifies that any player check returned by a bank unpaid and which is uncollectible is an expense toward the expense limitation. This clarification is in concert with a present gaming administrative rule (North Dakota Administrative Code 10-04-1-05-07(4)).

Also, this engrossed bill restates present law that cash shorts incurred in games of chance are an expense toward the expense limitation.

Since this engrossed bill reflects no real changes, there is no fiscal effect.
