Narrative:

Sections 1 through 9 of this bill have no fiscal impact.

Section 10 of the bill has a potentially significant fiscal impact but it is not possible to determine what it would be as the bill is written. As written the bill sets up a situation in which 14 large districts would be viewed as provider districts and be eligible to provide educational services to up to 266 other districts. The exact number of districts and total enrollments that would be involved in pairing relationships is impossible to determine. Since the 266 districts who could pair with 14 large districts have a total enrollment of approximately 60,000 students the fiscal impact could be significant.


