Narrative:

Since the bill carries no appropriation, there will be no direct fiscal impact resulting from passage of this bill. The Department would carry out the functions outlined in the bill, to the extent possible, based on the level of appropriation granted by the Legislature. Current expenditures for similar activities in the Economic Development Commission's Tourism Promotion Division are \$3.1 million per biennium, of which \$1.8 million is Highway Funds and \$1.3 million is general funds.
