In the following space note the fiscal effect in dollars of this measure:

Narrative:

By raising the annual entrance fee to state parks by \$5.00 per vehicle, the positive cash inflow to the Parks and Recreation Department and State General Fund will be \$28,500. Although approximately 6,000 passes are sold for the biennium, we do anticipate a slight decrease (10%) in the number purchased with the price increase.

Repeal of Section 55-08-06.2 which allows entrance without charge to North Dakota residents who are sixty years of age or older to state parks and recreation areas will generate an additional \$30,000. We anticipate that approximately one-third of those who now annually apply for and receive these permits will pay the annual fee. The figure quoted takes into consideration that approximately 70% of current seniors with park passports will not retain them initially.


