Narrative:

The passage of SB 2069 would require the State Auditor's Office to add an additional 13 auditors to existing staff. The cost would be funded by the State General Fund.

However, even without passage of SB 2069, the State Auditor's Office intends to annually audit the State's general purpose financial statements, which will require an additional 13 auditors.

This bill also provides that the Auditor's office would collect and disburse the amounts necessary to pay for audits performed by independent auditors. This would require additional special fund authority.

The dollar effect shown below is based on estimates.
