Narrative:

The current law requires publishers to provide copies of the most current textbooks to be kept on file in the office of the State Superintendent. For many years this library occupied about 350 square feet on the 9th floor of the State Capitol. Because of space considerations, it was moved to the Bismarck Teacher Center in 1988. That Center uses space donated by the Bismarck School District, which also has a shortage of space.

Since sample copies of textbooks are readily available from publishers and since the library is little used, no adverse effect is foreseen in its elimination. There will be some cost savings in space and handling, but those costs would be difficult to ascertain and would be minimal.
