Narrative:

Historically, the fees collected from Interstate Motor Carriers who register its Interstate Commerce Commission authority and purchase identification stamps have been credited to the State's general fund.

The fees collected for the 1989-1991 biennium to be credited to the general fund will be five million dollars.

The projected fees to be collected for the 1991-1993 biennium will be five million dollars. The projected fees are not expected to diminish in the future, and in fact, may increase slightly. The 1991-1993 fees will be credited to the highway fund.


