Narrative:

If enacted, HB 1615 will add currently exempt farm buildings to the tax rolls.

The fiscal impact of HB 1615 would increase the state medical center fund by +\$2,900 to \$5,700, the property tax revenue to counties by +\$248,000 to +\$495,000 and the property tax revenue to cities by +\$184,000 to +\$369,000 for the 1991-93 biennium.
