1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: Passage of this Bill will eliminate the need for the Health Department to license and inspect restaurants, lodging facilities, mobile home parks and campgrounds. It would result in a loss in General Fund revenue collections of \$100,230 and a savings in general fund expenditures of \$633,614 for a net savings of **\$533,384**


