Requested by Legislative Council Date of Request: 3-19-93

- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

If enacted as amended, HB 1103 First Engrossment would require the Land Department to make payments in lieu of property taxes to the political subdivisions. The cities and counties would receive the same revenue that would be levied as a possessory interest assessment.

This bill, if passed as amended, would reduce special funds by approximately -\$108,300 during the 1993-95 biennium and by approximately -\$118,500 during the 1995-97 biennium.
