

Fiscal Note for HB 1185

The fee increase proposed by this bill is one of several proposed by the Commission to help cover costs associated with the Motor Carrier Division. Passing this bill will increase the application fee for a transfer of a Permit or Certificate by \$50, and by assessing a \$100 fee when requesting temporary authority or temporary control of a Permit or Certificate. Since July 1, 1991 through the end of 1992, the Commission has processed 27 transfer of Permit or Certificate applications. I believe it is safe to assume that in the next six months the Commission will process at least three more like applications, making a total of 30 such applications for the 1991-93 biennium. Since July 1, 1991 through the end of 1992 the Commission has processed 12 requests for temporary authority or control and I believe it is safe to assume that the Commission will handle 3 more such requests before the end of the present biennium. All monies collected go to the general fund and the impact of the passage of this bill will be to enhance the general fund by \$3000. The increase of fee for the transfer application will account for \$1500 a biennium and the fee for a temporary authority or control will account for \$1500.
