Narrative: This fiscal note reflects the subject bill as it was passed by the Senate on 3/17/93. The Senate version only includes Section 2 of the House version of the bill. In the House version of section 2, the portion of the fees which would come to this office were specifically listed. In the Senate version, this specific portion was eliminated. It is the intent of this office to collect its share of the fees under this bill as allowed in NDCC 42-09-42.8. This is the same section which allows this office to collect its share of the \$10 UCC filing fee.


