1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: This fiscal note reflects the subject bill as it was agreed to in conference committee on April 23, 1993. The surcharge in Section 1 of the bill is intended to offset the deficiency in the Secretary of State's office during the 1991-93 biennium which was related to the Central Indexing System. It will sunset on June 30, 1995. Section two of the bill increases fees for searches from \$5 to \$7. The general fund will receive the \$2 increase as allowed in NDCC 42-09-42.8
