Narrative: The Small Operators Assistance Program, if amended by HB 1271, will pay most of the front-end costs of an applicant for a surface coal mining permit if the applicant's annual production will not exceed 300,000 tons. The money to pay for these costs is Federal money available to the Public Service Commission as a grant from the Office of Surface Mining, U.S. Department of the Interior.
