- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: The estimated cost of transportation reimbursement to North Dakota school districts for the 93-95 biennium as proposed in the department's budget is \$35,532,000. It is difficult or impossible to estimate the amount of this appropriation which may be saved as a result of the provisions of House Bill 1316. A likely outcome of adoption of this bill would be that school districts which are now required to provide transportation would continue to provide transportation but would implement transportation fees which would be charged to those patrons who ride school buses in the district. Those fees would be set at a level designed to offset the difference between state reimbursement and local district transportation costs. The net affect of this approach would be zero savings in state transportation reimbursement.
