1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

This bill will enable several additional class B gaming organizations to operate pull tab dispensing devices at licensed alcoholic beverage establishments and have the establishments assist the organizations by paying players for redeemed winning pull tabs. Presently, if a class B organization's quarterly adjusted gross proceeds (gross proceeds less prizes) exceeds \$60,000, the organization does not qualify. This bill will increase the quarterly adjusted gross proceeds limitation to \$100,000. Also, this bill will enable several class B organizations, which now qualify, to continue to qualify and retain their gaming sites.
