1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: This bill would provide vaccines to practitioners for administration to minors at no charge. As a fiscal impact to the state and the Health Department it would require an additional \$389,559 in general fund support. This would cover the increase in the per dose cost over the previously projected need of \$303,387 for vaccine and include \$20,000 estimated to administer the program.
