Narrative:

This is an omnibus bill related to games of chance. The bill clarifies ambiguities and definitions, adds several eligible (charitable) uses of gaming net proceeds, refines the classification of Class A and Class B organizations, limits a licensed organization to thirty gaming sites, increases the monetary fine applied to manufacturers, licenses manufacturers and manufacturers' distributors of pull tab dispensing devices, and classifies as a class C felony a fraudulent scheme or technique to cheat or skim involving the game of twenty-one.
