1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: Currently, there are 28 non-resident students attending approved alternative education programs in the state. Many of these students are paying tuition to attend these programs. It is anticipated that if these students did not have to pay tuition, the number of non-resident students would increase over the next biennium. This fiscal note assumes that there would be 40 students during the 1993-94 school year and 50 during the 1994-95 school year. This amounts to \$ 57,600.00 for the biennium (90 students x \$ 640.00).
