1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: Ninety-nine percent of the wages in state and local government are from reimbursable rather than tax-rated accounts and would not be affected by HB 1491. There has been one case in the recent past which did involve a tax-rated local government account. That account was billed for \$1,500, which would not have been applicable under HB 1491. However, no reliable estimate of future occurrences can be made.
