1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: S. B. No. 2032 contains no fiscal implications other than those already considered in Section 27-05-02.1 by the Fifty-Second Legislative Assembly. The changes specified by S. B. No. 2032 are mechanical in nature and provide one technical correction. The mechanical changes provide for an orderly process to abolish district judgeships, should that be required under Section 27-05-02.1. The technical correction deals with a change in the number of judges on July 1, 1999, from 44 to 42, making this number consistent with other provisions of Section 27-25-02.1.
