Removes sunset clause on Section 39-24-05, which provides the gas tax collected on 30 gallons gas for every registered snowmobile will be transferred from the highway tax distribution fund and credited to the state snowmobile fund for snowmobile programs and facilities. No change from previous bienniums. Transfers approximately \$100,000 from Highway Fund to Snowmobile Fund
