1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

SB 2152 would not change the amount of money collected by the geological survey for publication sales. Funds currently collected from publications sales are deposited into the general fund. Expenditures for publications and maps paid from our current appropriations are funded through Land and Minerals Trust Fund. Revenue for a biennium from publication sales would amount to approximately \$12,000, expenditures run about \$45,000. The difference would come out of our appropriated funds. There would be no fiscal impact on counties or cities.
