Requested by Legislative Council Date of Request: 1-11-93

- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

This bill will result in a loss of revenue for the Highway Tax Distribution Fund because it provides for the proration of fees that are currently not prorated. However, it is not possible to accurately estimate the extent of the revenue loss because no statistics are kept regarding the number of unregistered vehicles that are sold or the number of months the registration is expired at the time of sale. Based on a recent survey of Bismarck auto dealership, the Department estimates the bill may result in a loss of revenue of \$200,000 per year.
