1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

SB 2358 would become effective on July 1, 1994 if the U.S. Department of Energy and the North Dakota Industrial Commission approve clean coal demonstration projects. The current forecast does not reflect the existence of a sizeable clean coal demonstration project. If one is approved, the positive fiscal effect (employment, wages, sales tax, etc.) must be considered and would likely offset the drop in State General Fund revenues.
