1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

SB 2360, if passed, increases the benefits for the property tax credit for senior citizens and disabled persons beginning with taxes payable in 1995. Enactment of SB 2360 will cause a decrease in the state's general fund of -\$1,010,000 in the 1995-97 biennium. There is no fiscal effect to the state for 1993-95. Cities and counties have no fiscal effect.
