- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative: Estimating the fiscal impact of SB 2395 is virtually impossible. The price of wheat is: a) function of weather, government policy and other factors affecting worldwide supply and b) demand for hard red spring and durum resulting from customer needs, competition, producer production and marketing practices, and government import and export policy.

Price levels above the July 1, 1993 average price received by farmers would mean greater revenue on the same number of bushels then under the present system. If prices after July 1 are lower, revenue would be lower.
